Position Summary: The System and Network Administrator works within a team that is responsible for helpdesk, server administration, network administration, digital security, application support, and software quality assurance. The team is responsible for assuring continuity of service for all servers, desktops, applications, and networking infrastructure. The System and Network Administrator functions as an integral part of the team, able to fluidly move between server administration, network administration, and infrastructure related tasks.

Job Responsibilities:

1. Design, deploy, and administer company LANs, WANs, telephony, and wireless networks, including servers, workstations, routers, hubs, switches, gateways, UPSs, and other hardware.
2. Proactively improve uptime and performance for all servers, applications, and networking.
3. In conjunction with the Infrastructure Team, responsible for disaster planning, backup, and recovery of all computer systems.
4. In conjunction with other Information Technology personnel, manage data security for Wycliffe Associates, including recommending best practices for local and globally distributed team members.
5. Design and improve the overall strategy for managing servers including pre-deployment imaging, software installation and updating, antivirus, and other system software.
6. In conjunction with the Director of Infrastructure, manage new equipment purchasing and deployment for all server systems, equipment, and peripherals.

7. Assist the Director of Infrastructure with various technical projects as needed.
8. Help manage vendor relationships and contracts for WAN, server hardware, server software, etc. as needed.
9. Configure networks to ensure their smooth and reliable operation for fulfilling business objectives and processes.
10. Monitor network performance and troubleshoot problem areas as needed.
11. Create and maintain documentation as it relates to network configuration, network mapping, processes, and service records.
12. Support developers with expertise in virtualization, cloud deployments, networking, and security to assist with development and deployment of applications.

7. Proven experience with network capacity planning, network security principles, and general network management best practices.
8. Working technical knowledge of current network hardware, protocols, and Internet standards.
9. Knowledge of applicable data privacy practices and laws.
10. Able to conduct research into networking issues and products as required, with proven analytical and problem-solving abilities.
11. Knowledgeable and skilled with both computer hardware and software.

12. Must have strong experience with Microsoft and Linux Server Operating Systems.
13. Experience in designing and supporting TCP/IP networks including wired and wireless technologies and firewalls.
14. Must be a creative troubleshooter for both hardware and software issues.
